

Downloading eBooks from CWMARS OverDrive catalog to the *NOOK*

Download *Adobe Digital Editions* (be sure to create an Adobe ID for yourself so that you will be able to transfer downloaded material to other devices.)

You will find the link to download this application at the CWMARS digital catalog. At the home page of the digital catalog, go to: **eBooks**, then **Help**, then **Quick Start Guide**.

Once you've downloaded this application, you are ready to download eBooks from the digital catalog. It is very helpful to read the brief entries under "*My Account*" *Help* in the Quick Start Guide so that you'll understand the terminology used to select and reserve titles in OverDrive.

Browse the eBooks in the digital catalog and select an *Adobe EPUB eBook* or an *Adobe PDF eBook* to download. If the title you select shows **add to cart** as an option it will be immediately available for download. (If the title does not show **add to cart** as an option you can click on **add to my waiting list** to reserve the title if you wish.) Click on **add to cart** and then **proceed to checkout**. Click on **confirm check out** and then **Download**. When the file download window appears, at the prompt "do you want to open or save this file" click open and the file will automatically download to *Adobe Digital Editions*.

Open *Adobe Digital Editions* and you should see the title you downloaded.

While you have the *Adobe Digital Editions* screen open, connect the **NOOK** to the computer using the USB cord.

If the *Adobe Digital Editions* device set-up window opens, click on Authorize device.

Click on the books icon in the upper left hand corner of the Adobe Digital Editions screen. You'll then see the **Nook** icon appear in the left pane of the *Adobe Digital Editions* screen.

Drag and drop the image of the book on to the **NOOK** icon.

Safely remove the **Nook** from your computer.

Book will then appear in *My Library* under *My Documents* on the **NOOK**.

(*On **NOOK** color, the book may appear in *My Digital Editions*.)
